Examinations

Generic cover sheets to be used in emergency situations for the written examinations. The following are available as PDFs in the IBIS library.

Generic examination paper cover sheet	When a pre-printed hard copy answer cover sheet is not available (generally due to a registration change/new registration being made after the second registration deadline) and an electronic copy has not been received in time for the examination concerned.
Generic MCQ answer sheet	When a pre-printed hard copy MCQ answer sheet is not available (generally due to a registration change/new registration being made after the second registration deadline). The IB is unable to supply electronic copies of MCQ answer sheets.

Completing writable portable document format (PDF) forms

When downloading a form for completion, select the version that is in the working language of the school, such as English, French or Spanish. Complete the form in the same language. However, there are exceptions to this general rule. In the case of theory of knowledge, form TK/PPD (for planning and preparation) is also available in Chinese, German and Japanese. For example, candidates using German as their response language should select the German version of the form and complete it in German. For group 1 subjects, forms must be selected in the working language of the school, but subject-specific information must be completed in the target language to ensure the information can be read by the examiner.

Coordinators are advised to use the current version of Adobe® Reader® software, which is available for free download from the Adobe website, when completing a writable PDF form; other reader software may corrupt or alter the file. Note that users may encounter errors using “Preview” software, and are hence advised to download and use the latest version of Adobe Reader. For example, PDF forms are not compatible with the Google Chrome PDF viewer plug-in. Chrome users should save the form, then reopen and complete with Adobe reader.

If it is necessary to complete a form using non-Roman script, a language pack update may be required from Adobe. Recent versions of the software should include a prompt to download an update if the desired language is “cut and pasted” into one of the forms.

Users should note that the links to the forms will open the required documents via your internet browser. Some technical issues may arise if your security settings on your device or local network prohibit Adobe software (such as Adobe Reader) from connecting to the internet (in which case please alter the settings on your device or refer to your institutions web manager or IT staff for assistance).
