- **1.** Evaluate the claim that for anthropology to be relevant today, it must take a universalistic rather than a particularistic perspective.
- **2.** Examine the relationship between structure-centred **and** agency-centred perspectives in the work of **one** anthropologist.
- **3.** Compare **two** of the following schools of thought in relation to **either** a materialist **or** an idealist perspective:
 - Marxism
 - feminism
 - · symbolic theories
 - structuralism.
- **4.** Discuss ways in which **either** a synchronic perspective **or** a diachronic perspective would contribute to the understanding of **one** of the following:
 - ethnic relations
 - inequality
 - ritual.
- **5.** Examine **either** a conflict-centred perspective **or** a cohesion-centred perspective with reference to **two** schools of thought.
