Answer **one** question. Refer closely to the works of **at least two** poets you have studied.

- 1. Dark though it may be, death is a subject often treated by poets, and with varying attitudes. In the work of **at least two** poets you have studied, show how different and/or similar treatments of death can be made into successful material for poems.
- 2. Imagery is surely one of the poet's most valuable tools. Making clear exactly what you mean by the term 'imagery', show how **at least two** poets in your study have used imagery to good effect in their poetry.
- 3. The voice or persona in poems is an important factor in their delivery and effect. In the work of **at least two** poets you have studied, show how the voice in the poems is managed so as to produce various effects in terms of emotion, wisdom, persuasion and so on.
- **4.** Often poetry addresses the differing or similar ways men and women live, think and operate in the world. In the work of **at least two** poets you have studied, show how they have reflected on, agreed or argued with notions about the two sexes.
- 5. Poets have distinctive ways of writing about their subjects. Choosing **at least two** poets you have studied, discuss how they have presented their material in different ways and what effects are achieved.
- **6.** "The heart has its reasons of which reason knows nothing." The interaction or conflict between feeling and thinking has long been considered by poets. In the work of **at least two** poets you have studied, explore how such interactions or conflicts contribute to the subject of some poems.
