Example H

This is an example of a rudimentary TOK essay that was awarded a mark of 1/10. The key issue with this essay is that it does not focus clearly on the title. The candidate has posed their own question at the end of the first paragraph ("to what extent does knowledge need to be proven?") and focused their answer on that question instead of the title set, which means that their response lacks relevance. This is a major issue with this essay. In addition, the discussion is unclear and very difficult to follow.
