- 3. Compare the ways in which marriage is a contractual agreement in **two** societies you have studied.
- **4.** Discuss how gender relations are reproduced through socialization.
- **5.** Describe and discuss the advantages and risks associated with leadership.
- **6.** Describe and analyse the division of labour in an economic system you have studied.
